



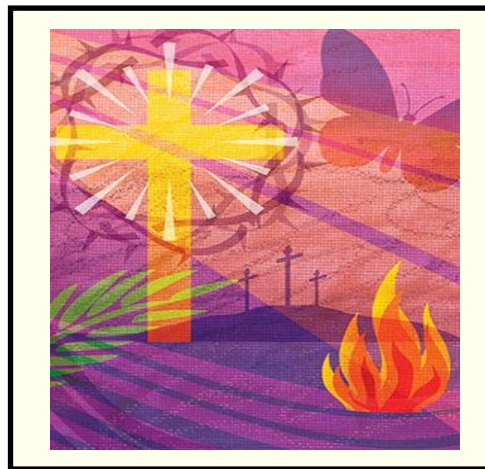

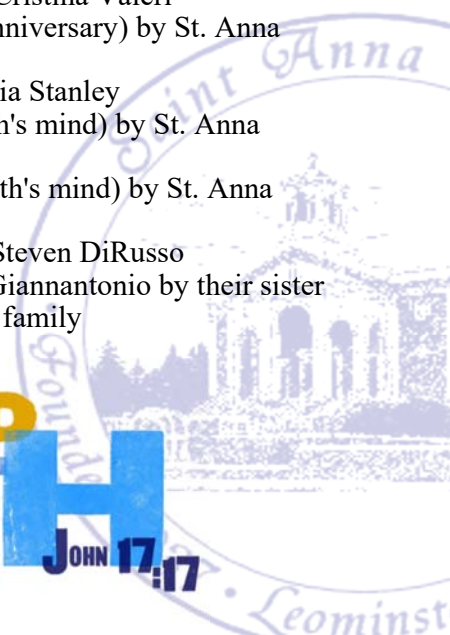

LHS YEARBOOKS WANTED

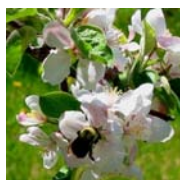
